1. THIS TOURNAMENT IS CERTIFIED BY THE UNITED STATES BOWLING CONGRESS AND ALL TOURNAMENT GAMES SHALL BE PLAYED IN STRICT COMPLIANCE WITH U.S.B.C. PLAYING RULES.
2. **ELIGIBILITY** - All participants must be 55 years of age or older as of October 20, 2007 and a member of the United States Bowling Congress for the current season, through either a regular league or senior league certified through a U.S.B.C. Local Bowling Association within New York State. Any entrant who does not qualify under the membership portion of this rule may become eligible through purchase of a USBC associate membership of \$21.00 PROVIDED they have been a resident of New York State for at least 30 days prior to the date of bowling. Proof of eligibility may be required at time of bowling.
3. **HANDICAP & ENTERING AVERAGE** - Handicap will be based on 90% of the participant's entering average and 210. The entering average will be the participant's HIGHEST U.S.B.C. certified average for 21 games or more from the 2006-2007 season, whether from a regular or seniors league. Spring or summer league averages will not be considered. Any entrant without an average from the 2006-2007 season, will use their HIGHEST U.S.B.C. certified average for 21 games or more from the 2005-2006 season, whether from a regular or seniors league. Any bowler without a U.S.B.C. certified average from the 2006-2007 season or the 2005-2006 season may use a U.S.B.C. certified average from the 2007-2008 season for 21 games or more whether from a regular or seniors league at the time of bowling. Any bowler using a 2007-2008 season U.S.B.C. average must submit written proof of this average from his league secretary or association manager prior to bowling. Any entrant without an average under this rule must bowl scratch without handicap.
4. **AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT & VERIFICATION** - All participants are required to familiarize themselves with the provisions of U.S.B.C. Rule 319e, pertaining to re-rating, and will be governed by application of that rule.

IT SHALL BE EACH BOWLER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF THEIR AVERAGE IN HANDICAP OR CLASSIFIED TOURNAMENTS, WHETHER THE AVERAGE WAS ORIGINALLY SUBMITTED BY THE BOWLER, THEIR CAPTAIN, OR OTHERS. FAILURE TO USE THE PROPER AVERAGE SHALL DISQUALIFY SCORE IF SUBMITTED AVERAGE IS LOWER THAN ACTUAL AVERAGE, OR CAUSE PRIZE WINNINGS TO BE BASED ON SUBMITTED AVERAGE IF IT IS HIGHER.

A participant must report previous tournament winnings in excess of \$300.00 in any event of any tournament between October 20, 2006 and October 20, 2007. Information provided must include actual score, position of finish in the event, the event, and the amount won.

Tournament Management reserves the right to re-rate or reject any entrant prior to participation.

5. **PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS** – Multiple participation shall be allowed as follows: (1) bowlers must enter and pay for both doubles and singles each time they enter; (2) bowlers must change partners each time they enter as the same two bowlers cannot bowl together more than once; and (3) bowlers can cash more than once in the doubles with different partners but a bowler can cash only once in the singles event. The bowler's first score in each event counts toward their six (6) game all events total. Bowlers must enter both the doubles and singles events. No split entries will be accepted. No doubles only and no singles only entries will be accepted. PBA members may compete but no 2 PBA members may bowl together in Doubles. Partners in the doubles event do not necessarily have to be members from the same age classification. Doubles classification shall be based on the age of the YOUNGER of the two bowlers with doubles prizes being paid for each age classification. For purposes of singles and all-events, each bowler will be classified according to their own age.

Doubles event will be bowled on one pair of lanes, singles on a different pair. Each doubles team captain will draw their starting lanes for the doubles event prior to the start of each squad. Doubles teams have the privilege of being paired together if the request is made prior to the draw for lanes and there are sufficient lanes not previously drawn to allow for such pairings. The singles event will be bowled on a different pair of lanes from the doubles event and will be the pair of lanes either adjacent to the left or the right of their doubles lanes according to the draw. Two, Four, or Six Bowlers will be placed on each pair of lanes depending upon the number of entries on each squad and lane availability.

6. **PRIZES AND AWARDS** - PRIZE FEES WILL BE RETURNED 100%. Prize ratio will be at least one prize for each ten entries or fraction thereof in each event. All prizes will be paid for scores with handicap. There will be a separate prize list for each age classification in doubles, singles, and all-events. The participant in each age classification with the highest all-events (6 game total) score including handicap will be eligible for participation in the 2008 USBC National Seniors Tournament with the entry fee for that tournament paid from the expense fees of this tournament. If the champion in any age division cannot bowl in the National Seniors Tournament, then alternates from the same age division may be sent, in order of finish.
