TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Entry in this tournament is open to all U.S.B.C. certified New York State bowlers. Individuals who are members of bowling organizations identified as “professional” are eligible for participation, however, not more than one pro can compete on a four member team or a two member doubles team.
2. Teams must consist of 2 men and 2 women. Doubles must be 1 man and 1 woman.
3. Multiple participation will be allowed in **both the team and doubles events** under the following conditions: 2 members of a team must change in the Team Event as not more than 2 members on the same team can bowl together more than once and 1 member must change in the Doubles Event as not more than one member on the same doubles team can bowl together more than once. The bowler’s first appearance in each event will count towards their six game all events total.
4. Handicap will be based on individual averages in each event, using the U.S.B.C. three game handicap chart. **All averages must be verified.**
5. Report and use averages from U.S.B.C. certified leagues only. Use highest U.S.B.C. certified league averages based on a minimum of 21 games from the 2006-2007 season. If current 21 game U.S.B.C. league average for the 2007-2008 season as of the scheduled bowling date in the tournament is 10 or more pins above bowler’s 2006-2007 U.S.B.C. league average, then current 2007-2008 season U.S.B.C. league average must be used. If no average from the 2006-2007 season, then use highest current U.S.B.C. certified league average for the 2007-2008 season for 21 games or more as of the scheduled bowling date in the tournament. All others must bowl scratch without handicap.
6. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby resulting in a lower classification or handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections in averages may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of a series (see U.S.B.C. Rules 319a-3, 319a-4). U.S.B.C. participants must be familiar with average adjustment USBC Rule 319e.
7. Entries close one hour prior to the last scheduled squad with entries on 11/18/07. WALK-IN entries will be allowed up to one hour before each squad time provided that there are lanes available.
8. Handicap - 100% from 220 scratch, no limit and no minus handicap
9. Entry fee is \$20.00 per bowler, per event (i.e. \$80.00 per Team and \$40.00 per Doubles), \$5.00 per person for optional all-events (6 game total, Team and Doubles), with a separate division for men and women. All entrants who bowl in both events are eligible for the all-events awards. Only those who pay the \$5.00 fee are eligible for the all-events prize list. Completed entry forms and fees must be forwarded to: **New York State USBC Bowling Association, P.O. Box 461, Auburn, New York 13021.**
10. Prize ratio will be at least 1 prize for each 8 entries in each event. All prize fees will be returned 100% within each event.
11. Total pins plus handicap for three games will determine prize winners.
12. Non-certified bowlers who reside in New York State may enter by paying the current U.S.B.C. associate membership fee of \$21.00.
13. Please report at least 30 minutes prior to your squad time with membership cards for each bowler.
14. **There will be a \$30.00 charge for all returned checks.**
